For example, students can become involved in agree/disagree discussions, the teacher can form group of students, there should be four or five in each group, and provide controversial topic like "people learn best when they read vs. people learn best when they travel". Then each group works on their topic for a given time and presents their view point for a given time and presents their views point to the class. It is important that the speaking should be equally shared among the group members. Finally the class should decide on the winning group, who presented the ideas in the best way. Through this the students critical thinking and quick decision making, and students learn how to express and justify themselves in polite ways while against the point of others. For efficient group discussions, it is always better not to form large groups.

Role play, Simulations, Information gap, Brain storming, Storytelling, Interviews, Story completion, Reporting, Narrating the picture, Find the difference are some of the activities through which the student can promote their speaking skill.

In the traditional classroom environment the Reading and Writing skills are given much importance compared to Speaking and Listening skills.
